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VECTOR INDIA INSTITUTE TERMS OF ADMISSION & REGULATIONS

Course fees are non-refundable and non-transferable:

The course fee once paid is non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.

Any candidate opting out of the programme or dropping out during the continuation of the programme shall be liable to pay the entire course fee and the same shall be recoverable by the institute from the candidate. A FEE of Rs. 6,000/- will be applicable for any reason of Batch/Branch shifting for Hyderabad, Bangalore, Chennai & Online Batches and the final decision will be at the discretion of senior management.

Admission and 10% Discount Eligibility:

Students eligible for a 10% discount must submit the Final Consolidated Marks Memo on or before the reporting date to avail the benefit.

Identity Card:

Student is requested to carry the Identity Card issued by Vector India, inside the VECTOR premises always and the same need to be produced for verification to the VECTOR authorities. In case of loss / damage duplicate Identity Card can be reissued with a penalty of Rs.100/- and one passport size photograph must be submitted by the student.

Theory Classes & Lab Practice:

Students will have theory class for one and half to three hours every day (6-day week), and you must practice for a minimum of 3hrs in the lab every day during the course. Depending on the requirement, the Institute will conduct parallel classes and students have to attend the additional classes as scheduled by the institute. The Institute will not be responsible for arranging backup classes for those bunking classes without prior notice or written permission from the director.

Tests and Examination:

Students must appear for the theory and practical test at the end of each week/module/ group of modules and at the end of the Course. The results will be evaluated and will be informed to the students periodically. Many companies recruit/short-list on the basis of the internal test scores. Re-Examination will not be conducted during the course. Students will be given two chances after the course to improve their scores.

Placement Assistance:

The offer of placement assistance does not constitute a guarantee of placement. While the institute shall make its best endeavor to place all its candidates, the placement of a candidate is dependent on numerous skills like subject knowledge, aptitude, attitude, communication skills, teamwork, and management skills etc., which are unique to each candidate. If a student either refuses or fails to attend an interview recommended by the placement in-charge without prior intimation (24Hrs in advance) mail to placementupdate@vectorindia.org, his/her name will be removed from the placement list. If the student declines a job offer, he/she will be removed from the placement list. Candidates who are not willing to relocate must update the same at the time of admission. Students should have their Back Logs cleared (if any) to be eligible for the placements. Candidates must carry resume, id to all recruitment events and honor short-listing done by companies. Students Should be willing to sign 2-3 years of bond with the company, which is a common requirement.

Vector Short listing Test:

Students should undergo Vector Short listing Test (VST) every 3 months if they have not secured a placement in any company within three months of becoming eligible for Campus Placements.

Assessment Interview:

Assessment interviews will be conducted by the Institute to filter the right candidates, as and when the Institute feels it's necessary.

One Offer Policy:

Students who get terminated or resign from companies after joining will not receive any placement assistance.

Eligibility for Placements:

Candidates must meet all the following criteria to be eligible for placement assistance.

Criteria	Eligibility
Attendance	75% and above in Theory and Lab (Technical, Aptitude & Communication)
Weekly/ Module Theory and Lab Exams (Technical, Aptitude & Communication)	40% & above in each
Assessment interview	Recommendation from the interviewer is must

Certification:

Candidates must maintain 75% attendance and should score min 40% aggregate in the exams to be eligible for Merit Certificate. Candidates scoring 30-39.9% will be eligible only for a participation certificate. Candidates with less than 50% attendance and/or internal scores below 30% will not receive any certification. They must improve through monthly tests.

Discipline:

Students are encouraged to utilize the facilities available to improve their knowledge. However, during the utilization of the available facilities, if any damage or loss occurs to the property, the student concerned will be liable to compensate for the damage/loss.

Lectures and Classes:
